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22 Before the Court is the Plaintiffs' Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary
23 Injunction ("Motion") filed on June 7, 2022. The Plaintiffs seek a temporary restraining order
24 specifically requesting an order that: (1) prohibits the Defendants from engaging in any disenrollment
25 activity, (2) requires the Defendants to retrieve Modoc Nation member files from the third party
26 accounting firm, Wipfli LLP, (3) prohibits the Defendants from holding themselves out as the lawful
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1 Elected Council of the Modoc Nation, and (4) prohibits the Defendants from taking any actions on
2 behalf of the Modoc Nation. Having reviewed the Plaintiffs' Complaint, Motion, and accompanying
3 exhibits, and finding that Plaintiffs have met their burden under Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(b) establishing the
4 necessity of a temporary restraining order, the Court hereby **GRANTS** the Plaintiffs' Motion and
5 **ORDERS** the following:

- 1 7 1. Defendants, and any other persons or entities acting in concert with or on behalf of the
2 Defendants, are temporarily restrained and enjoined from engaging in any
3 disenrollment activity, which includes any ongoing membership audit.
- 4 9 2. Defendants, and any other persons or entities acting in concert with or on behalf of the
5 Defendants, are ordered to immediately retrieve all Modoc Nation membership files
6 from Wipfli, LLP.
- 7 11 3. Defendants are ordered to immediately stop holding themselves out as the lawful
8 Elected Council of the Modoc Nation.
- 9 13 4. Defendants are ordered to immediately stop taking any actions on behalf of the Modoc
10 Nation.


15 In addition, the Court **ORDERS** the following:

- 16 1. A hearing will be held on June 14th, 2022, at 10:00am to determine whether a
17 preliminary injunction should be issued. This hearing shall be held at Modoc Nation
18 Headquarters.
- 19 2. At the hearing, the Plaintiffs shall be prepared to show cause why a preliminary
20 injunction should be issued.
- 21 3. At the hearing, the Defendants shall be prepared to show cause why they should not be
22 preliminary enjoined during the pendency of this action.
- 23 4. In accordance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(b)((2), this order expires in 14 days or on or
24 before June 21st, 2022, unless the Court, for good cause, extends the order for a
like period or the adverse party consents to a longer extension.

25 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
